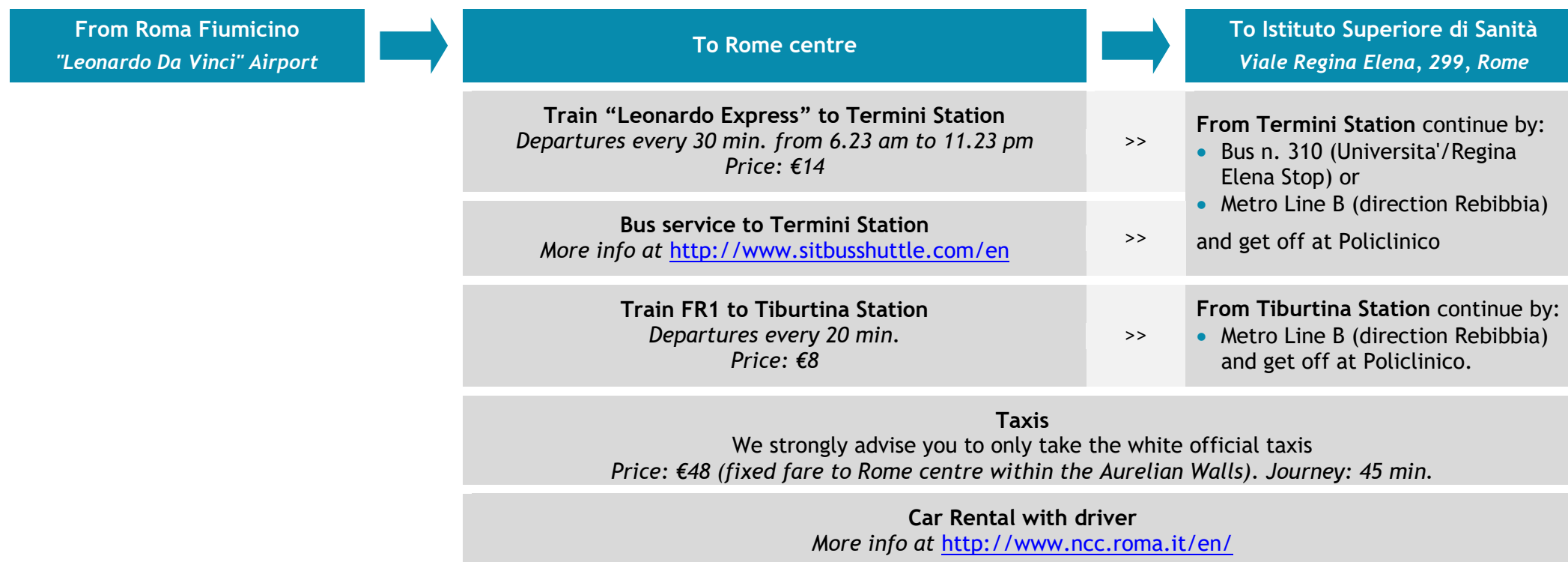
TRANSPORT

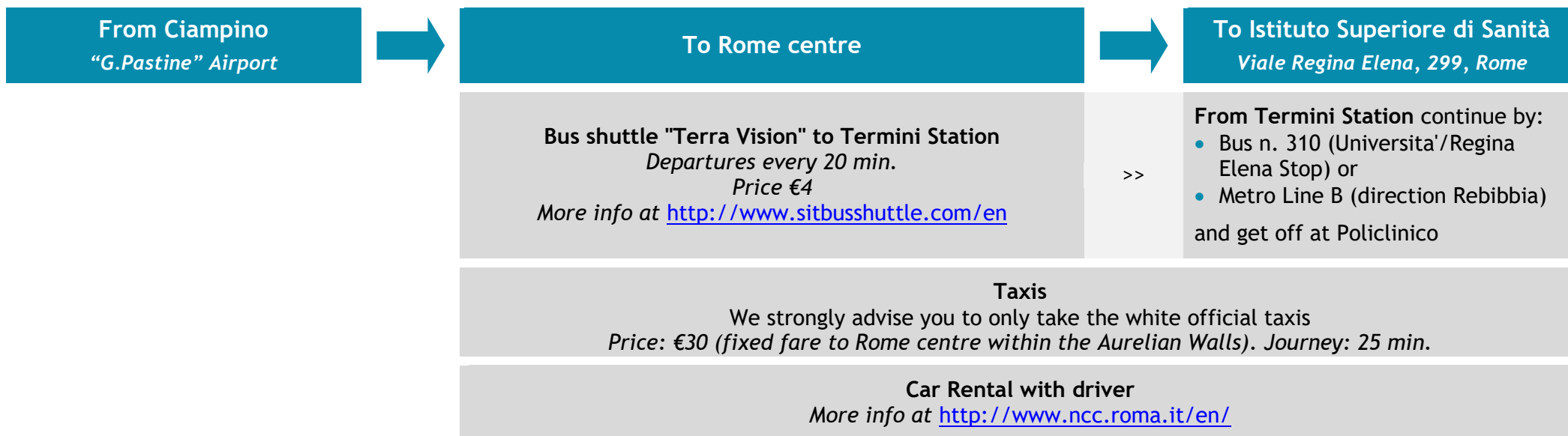
Participants must plan and pay their own travel arrangements for both outward and return journeys.

If you are getting to Rome BY TRAIN:


Rome is in the heart of the European Rail Network and is the key hub of the national network:

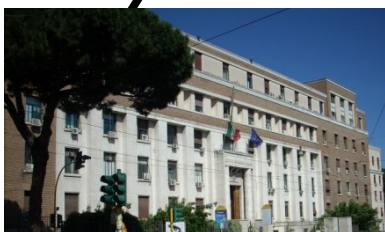
Termini Central Railway Station is the point of arrival and departure for almost all trains from Italy and abroad. Most public buses leave from Termini Station to the different areas of the city and the two existing underground lines have their changing terminal there.

Tiburtina Railway Station is second largest station in Rome. Located in the north-eastern part of the city, it is connected to the Rome's Metro line B.

HOTELS
