




#### AMR burden of disease and its mitigation by NAPs



#### Mortality according to NAPs status across WHO Euro








## NAP: more than just a paper exercise (1)

NAPs and policies are dynamic processes that require time and efforts to be fully implemented










## Example: IPC actions and policy

**Overall goal:** to ensure that infection prevention and control measures in human health are put in place and continuously monitored to contribute to limiting the spread of antimicrobial resistant pathogens



**Policy:** adequate embedding of IPC measures in policy and NAP



# objectives

#### 2023 Council Recommendation on AMR with OH approach

- Builds on and complements 2017 European One Health Action Plan against AMR
- Provide recommendations to the Commission and to Member States in order to maximize synergies and to attain a strong and effective response against AMR across the EU and across One Health sectors

Strengthen One Health national action plans on AMR Reinforce surveillance and monitoring of AMR and antimicrobial consumption

Strengthen infection prevention and control

Strengthen antimicrobial stewardship and prudent use of antimicrobials

Recommend targets for AMR and antimicrobial consumption in human health

Improve awareness, education and training Foster research &
development, and incentives for
innovation and access to
antimicrobials and other AMR
medical countermeasures

Increase cooperation



Follow-up on progress of the Council Recommendation on fighting against AMR and the 'EU One Health Action Plan on AMR' (follow-up report, monitoring)

### AMR coordination – AMR One Health Network



#### Members:

- MS experts from the human health, animal health and environmental sectors
- relevant EU scientific agencies
- stakeholders
- Commission experts

**Meeting twice per year** to enhance the coordination & dialogue between the human health, veterinary and environmental sectors in the EU institutions, Member States and with stakeholders, in policies to address AMR, in a One Health approach



#### Council Recommendation on AMR

#### The Council:

- welcomes the Commission's intention to develop a monitoring framework to assess the progress and results achieved in implementing the AMR Action Plan and the Council Recommendation. -> monitoring framework developed
- Enhance the cooperation on AMR between EFSA, EMA, ECDC, EEA and ECHA
   & reinforce the One Health approach on AMR through an interagency AMR working group. -> to be set up soon
- Report to the Council four years after adoption on the follow-up given to this Recommendation (-> report by 2027)







## Support to EU MS

#### **Funding and resources**

- <u>EU4Health</u>: we have financed AMR actions with a total of **EUR 76 million**, including EU JAMRAI-2 funding
- <u>SMP Food</u>: we have financed actions for **EUR 22 million**, including support to MS for setting up their national systems for data collection and reporting on antimicrobial sales and use in animals, and for implementing coordinated control programmes to monitor AMR in certain food and food-producing animals
- Horizon Europe: support research and innovation on AMR (new antibiotics, diagnostics, vaccines, and AMR alternatives)
   more than €1 billion mobilized in the period 2014-2024, and we will contribute with up to €100 million to the new One Health AMR Partnership.

Facilitating collaborations: AMR OH Network, upcoming interagency AMR WG

Building capacity through trainings: BTSF trainings, trainings to veterinarians and farmers on VMP Regulation

**Raising awareness**: teenager campaign last year ('Beat the Bug' Fortnite game), educational material, journalists workshop...

#### **Global Actions**

#### 2024 UNGA Political Declaration

#### Governance:

- Actionable national action plans in all countries
- Quadripartite to update Global Action Plan by 2026
- Establishment of an Independent Panel on Evidence for Action on AMR in 2025



#### **Human and Animal Health**

**Financing**: mobilize US\$ 100 million to support at least 60% of countries to have funded NAPs

Access R&D and innovation Surveillance systems Monitoring....

#### 4<sup>th</sup> Ministerial Meeting in Jeddah / "Jeddah Commitments"

Translate the Political Declaration from the United Nations General Assembly High-Level Meeting on AMR into practical commitments for urgent actions.



Operationalises some of the UNGA commitments

- Global and national governance
- Stewardship and surveillance
- Capacity development
- R&D, manufacturing, access and disposal



## Other global initiatives

#### **AMR Multi-Partner-Trust-Fund (MPTF)**

- Transforms AMR National Action Plans from words to action through OH multi-year country programs in LMICs
- Mechanism to secure consistent and coordinated financing for addressing AMR through a One Health approach
- Approximately 30 million EUR
- Partners: EU, NL, SE, DE, and UK



#### **UNGA Political Declaration:**

 Commitments for expanding the numbers of contributors to the MPTF

#### **AMR Multi-Stakeholder Partnership Platform (MSPP)**

- Launched in 2023 with EU support
- 200+ members from research and academia, civil society, governments, intergovernmental institutions, private sectors, financial institutions
- Drives multidisciplinary action at global, regional, and national levels through Actions Groups working on key issues of multisectoral interest
- Shares and enhances knowledge, evidence, and innovation to underpin key AMR actions, policy recommendations, and guidance.



#### **UNGA Political Declaration**:

Role reinforced through the commitment to enhance existing mechanisms to facilitate multisectoral exchange of experiences

Financial support to the future Independent Panel for Action on AMR in 2025






