

1 THE VENUE

The EU-JAMRAI 2 Annual Meeting 2026 will be held in:

Urania-Sternwarte – Uraniastraße 1, 1010 Wien



The meeting room is called “Mittlerer Saal” and has a direct entry in the east of the building.

Urania is a public education institute, the building also houses an observatory and a puppet theatre; infos about the building: https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Urania,_Vienna

How to get to the venue:

(see also general info about public transport: in Section 4. Tourist Information)

- **BY TRAM:**


- Nearest stop is line 1, Stop called “Julius Raab-Platz (Uraniastraße)”,
- alternatively you can take line 2, Stop “Julius Raab-Platz (Stubenring)
- or line O Stop “Hintere Zollamtstraße”

- **BY UNDERGROUND:**

- Nearest stop is U1 (red line) or U4 (green line) stop “Schwedenplatz”, from there it's a 7 minutes walk to the venue; alternatively you can take one stop with tramlines 1 or 2
- U3 (orange line) stop “Stubenring”, from there you can take tramline 2 for 1 stop

- **BY CAR:**


There is no free street parking anywhere in Vienna, best to find a park & ride facility, possibly next to underground line U1, U3 or U4: Park & Ride, garage parking - vienna.info



2 GETTING TO VIENNA

Vienna Airport is outside the city limits. Be sure to have a valid ticket for that area. See [video showing all transportation options](#) (Vienna Airport to the City in 22mins).

Look up the best option for your arrival time at <https://anachb.vor.at/>



From Vienna airport:

- Direct trains from the airport to “Wien Mitte Station” (from there is a 10 minutes walk to the venue or alternatively tram line O)
 - Take train S7 **or** REX7 **or** CAT (more expensive but slightly quicker)
- Vienna Airport bus line 2 “VAB2” to Mortinplatz/Schwedenplatz every 30 minuntes, see page 2 of <https://www.viennaairportbus.com/de/dam/jcr:f2c24e7d-d3d7-44e9-9329-0112a136099e/fahrplan-vab2.pdf> (7 minutes walk or tram 1, or 2)

From main train station (Hauptbahnhof):

- Subway U1 to “Schwedenplatz” (7 min. walk or tram 1, or 2) **or**
- Tram O to “Hintere Zollamtsstraße” (5 min. walk)

From west train station (Westbahnhof):

- Subway U3 to “Stubentor” (10 min. walk or tram 2)

From international bus station (Erdberg):


- Subway U3 to “Stubentor” (10 min. walk or tram 2)

3 ACCOMODATION

The venue is located in the citycenter. Here are hotel options in walking distance:

Alternativly good options would be **anywhere along the underground lines U1 or U4**




4 TOURIST INFORMATION

General **public transport** info:

- **Tickets** can be purchased in advance online, in the official mobile app or at a vending machine at every underground stop, but **NOT** on the bus, and only on some of the trams.

 - caution: Googlemaps mostly works, but doesn't contain current disruptions etc
